Case Summary:

At the starting signal, SUI 216180 was identified in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark.

Procedural Matters:

SUI 216180 was absent and PC held a hearing under RRS 63.3(b).

Facts Found:

1. The preparatory signal for race number 9 was a black flag.
2. At the starting signal, SUI 216180 was identified in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark by the race committee vessel at the starboard end of the starting line.
3. Following the starting signal, the race committee signaled a general recall and before the next warning signal displayed the sail number of SUI 216180.

Conclusion & Rules:

There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
