Case Summary:

BEL 218406 was given a score of BFD (disqualification under RRS 30.4) in race number 4.

Procedural Matters:

- 1. BEL 218406 lodged her request for redress after the protest time limit. As soon as BEL 218406 came ashore, she sought video and audio evidence of the start of race number 4 from the race committee. As a result, she was delayed in her submission of her request for redress. The protest committee deemed that this was a good reason and extended the protest time limit as provided in RRS 62.2.
- 2. Mark Little John (coach) and Tamas Eszes (coach) attended the hearing as observers.

Facts Found: -

- 1. The preparatory signal for race number 4 was a black flag.
- 2. The race committee presented video evidence of the start of race number 4. The video was taken from the race committee vessel at the port end of the starting line.
- 3. At the starting signal, BEL 218406 was identified in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark by the race committee vessel at the port end of the starting line.
- 4. BEL 218406 was given a score of BFD (disqualification under RRS 30.4) in race number 4.

Conclusion & Rules:

There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.

Decision:

Redress is not given.
