### Case Summary:

### Procedural Matters:

Parties come to the hearing after arbitration under Appendix T and SI 1.4  
Observers: Tsolis Harris coach of CYP

### Facts Found:

In race #4 with 7/8 knots of wind with small choppy waves.  
ITA 219811 was sailing on port and tacked on starboard 2 boat lengths from the finishing pin end mark on the starboard lay line.  
CYP 218181 was sailing on port on a converging course of ITA approaching the mark  
One boat length from ITA CYP luffed up to tack on starboard and a half boat length from the pin end mark.  
Immediately CYP finished her tack ITA luffed to avoid CYP  
No contact occurred  
No boat took a penalty

### Conclusion & Rules:

When CYP acquired right of way, she initially gave ITA room to keep clear, because ITA could luff in a seamanlike way and avoid CYP.
