Case Summary:

Technical Committee protest against a boat.

Procedural Matters:

OMA 219585 did not attend the hearing. The hearing was held under RRS 63.3(b) in her absence.

Facts Found:

In a post-race on-the-water inspection after race 3, the Technical Committee found that the end of the kicker line of OMA 219585 was tied to a shock cord (centreboard retaining line).

OMA 21958 raced with this equipment in races 1, 2 and 3.

Conclusion & Rules:

OMA 21958 is in breach of ILCA CR 3.b(x) in races 1, 2 and 3.

RRS 64.4(c) permits the protest committee to penalize the boat in all races sailed with this equipment.

SI 5.4 permits a discretionary penalty for a breach of a class rule.

The percentage will be calculated according to World Sailing Discretionary Penalty Policy.

Decision:

Using the Discretionary Penalty Policy, a starting penalty of Band 1, 5% was decided.

There were no facts to justify increasing or decreasing the penalty.

OMA 21958 is penalized in races 1, 2 and 3, 5% calculated to the nearest tenth of a point, (0.05 to be rounded upward), but no worse than the score for DNF.

No other boat's score shall change.

Short Decision:

OMA 219585 is penalized 5% in races 1, 2 and 3.
