Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

1. The panel of the international jury was composed in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).
2. Christos Theodosis (jury member) attended the hearing as an observer.

Facts Found:

1. The protest time limit for the girl's yellow fleet was 16:45.
2. After coming ashore, MEX 199728 was cleaning and de-rigging her boat for 15-20 minutes.
3. MEX 199728 submitted her request at 16:52.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. MEX 199728 failed to deliver the protest within the protest time limit, as required by RRS 61.3.
2. There was no good reason for the international jury to extend the time.

Decision:

The protest is invalid, the hearing is closed under RRS 63.5.

Short Decision:

The protest is invalid because it was submitted outside of the protest time limit. There was no good reason to extend the time.
