

ENTRY AND DEPARTURE OF THE PORT

The entry and exit to the harbour is coordinated by the Organising Committee, Chief Safety Officer and the Port Authority. This instruction is for the safety of the competitors and is to be read in conjunction with the diagram attachedt

Inside the harbour boats shall always sail to the north keeping the commercial channel free. The safety red marks located outside the harbour shall always be passed, leaving the marks to starboard when exiting and to port when entering as per Attachment 3, unless the safety vessel in the area is displaying the following flag:

- a) Green flag it is safe to exit and enter directly without going around the red marks.
- b) Red flag all boats shall wait in the closest waiting area (1, 2 or 3) until further instruction is provided by the safety vessel in the vicinity.
