Case Summary:

CRO 217717 alleging that AUS 222424 did not give her mark-room at mark 5.

Procedural Matters:

1. An arbitration meeting was held.
2. Laura Slocka - from the race committee was an observer at the hearing.

Facts Found:

1. The wind was about 20 knots.
2. AUS 222424 and CRO 217717 on port were reaching to mark 5 to be rounded to port.
3. At the zone CRO 217717 was clear ahead of AUS 222424 .
4. AUS sailing faster than CRO 217717 established an inside overlap.
5. CRO 217717 bore away to avoid contact with AUS 222424 and AUS 222424 sailed between CRO 217717 and mark 5.
6. There was no contact between the boats or with the mark.
7. o boat took a penalty.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. AUS 222424 clear astern at the time CRO 217717 reached the zone failed to give CRO 217717 mark-room, and broke RRS 18.2(b).
2. AUS 222424 to windward failed to keep clear of CRO 217717 to leeward, and broke RRS 11.

Decision:

AUS 222424 is DSQ in Race 1 as a boat clear astern at the zone failing to give mark room.

Short Decision:

AUS 222424 is DSQ in Race 1 as a boat clear astern at the zone failing to give mark-room.
