Case Summary:

The Race committee did not give a fair race 7.

Procedural Matters:

Facts Found: -

- 1. The race 7 was outer loop. The wind was light.
- 2. AUS 222373 was sailing downwind in leg 3 to gate mark 3 in leading position.

3. There was a wind shift of 65 degree to the left. The gate mark boat showed Charley-Red with proper signal. At that time the new mark 2 was not in place.

4. Most of the first group boats rounded gate mark 3P. The few boats of the first group rounded gate mark 3S. When AUS 222373 rounded mark 2 on her second beat, her position was dropped to about 15 places.

- 5. The Race committee continue to finish the race.
- 6. The Race committee stated that they followed WS guidelines.

Conclusion & Rules: -

There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.

Decision:

Redress is not given.
