Port & starboard incident on first leg

#### Procedural Matters: -

## Facts Found: —

- The incident was at first upwind leg, about first quarter of the leg.
- The wind was about 12 knots, moderate adverse current with 1 foot wave.
- THA 223144 was closehauled on starboard. ITA221008 was closehauled on port. Both boats were on collision course.
- When two boats were 3 meters apart, THA 223144 bore to pass ITA 221008 astern.
- 5. If THA 223144 had not born away she would have collided with ITA 221008 starboard guarter.
- 6. No boat took penalty turns.

## Conclusion & Rules: —

ITA 221008 on port failed to keep clear of THA 223144 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
