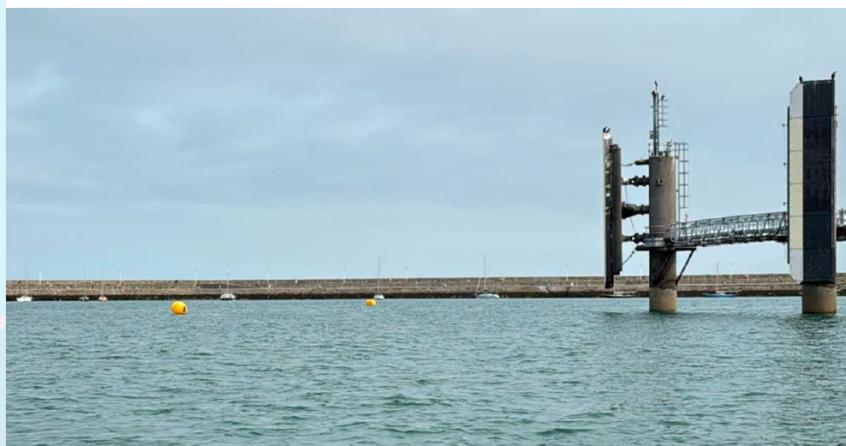
HARBOUR FAIRWAY CROSSING REQUIREMENTS

To facilitate the transfer of passengers by tender from cruise liners at anchor in Dublin Bay to the cruise liner tender jetty (pier to the west of the RSGYC), the fairway in Dun Laoghaire Harbour between the jetty and the harbour entrance must be kept clear of sailing and support vessels on the dates below.

24/08/2026	Monday	Carnival Legend
28/08/2026	Friday	Viking Saturn
29/08/2026	Saturday	Majestic Princess
30/08/2026	Sunday	Viking Sky

To mark the route for ILCAs and support vessels to and from the racing area, large yellow buoys will be laid at the designated crossing point of the harbour fairway. All vessels are kindly requested to cross the fairway at right angles at this location and exit/enter the harbour entrance on the west side of the fairway (keeping clear of fishermen's lines off the end of the west pier of Dun Laoghaire Harbour).

The image below indicates the fairway in red, the approximate positioning of the yellow buoys and the route in blue to/from the racing area for ILCA and support vessel crossing. Your co-operation with this procedure is appreciated.



Please note the 'Clear Fairway Priorities: Large power-driven vessels (Cruise, Ferries, Lighthouse Authorities, Naval) and smaller power-driven vessels with restricted manoeuvrability (such as cruise ship tenders and small

passenger ferries etc) have priority over all other craft, including the area of the harbour limits that extend 600 metres seaward of the harbour mouth.'
