Procedural Matters:

Facts Found:

- Wind at the starting procedure was about 12 knots.
- GRE 150374 was approaching Starting Line on close reach on starboard 40s before Starting signal.
- ITA 218367 was windward of GRE 150374 at least 2 m away, and about a meter forward from the other boat.
- ITA 218367 started to bear away, GRE 150374 hailed and ITA responded by luffing.
- When ITA 218367 crossed the bow of GRE 150374 they were two meters apart.
- There was no contact.

Conclusion & Rules:

ITA 218367 to windward kept clear of GRE 150374 to leeward. No rule broken.
